Visit the North Carolina Maritime Museum in Beaufort for a taste of coastal cultures and a rich maritime history. Exhibits feature the state's important seafood industry, whales and whaling, surfing, life-saving stations and lighthouses, and its varied working and recreational watercraft.

The "Blackbeard's *Queen Anne's Revenge*" exhibit illuminates the life of early 18th-century pirates. The Museum is the official repository for the artifacts from Blackbeard's flagship, which ran aground near Beaufort in 1718.
